PACKING TIPS

- Pack smaller items together in a bag to keep them from floating loosely in your pack.
- Pack items in ziploc backs to keep them dry.
- Roll clothing items for easier packing.
- Stuff softer items around the outside to fill the space.
- Keep your camping gear stored together at home, for example on a shelf or in a storage box.
- Leave standard items packed in your pack when you store it.
- Space option, you can leave your pillow at home. Stuff your sleeping bag stuff sack with clothing and use as a pillow to save room in your backpack.
